Interested in joining the PCC?

PCC members for 2018-19 are elected at the Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM) on 29th April 2018.

This year we need to elect up to 12 members, which should include representatives from both of our churches. On top of this we also elect two Churchwardens and our Deputy Wardens. At present, PCC members serve for a one-year term.

The legal part - You need to be:

- On the Electoral Roll
- Someone who attends worship regularly
- Over 16
- The PCC is a charity, the PCC are the trustees, so you must not be legally barred from being a charity trustee

PCC members:

- Are trustees of the charity (please see trustee leaflet to find out more about the duties and responsibilities of trustees)
- Are representatives of our two congregations
- Share in making decisions about the life and work of the church, in partnership with the clergy
- Work with the clergy to promote 'the whole mission of the Church, pastoral, evangelistic, social and ecumenical'.
- Serve in a position of leadership, and as such are expected to be committed Christians, and to attend worship regularly
- Are expected to attend the meetings (approx. 10 meetings a year), and to prepare for the meetings by reading any necessary paperwork.
- Have the opportunity to shape the agenda, and suggest items for discussion
- Can make a real difference to the church and to the parish!
