### Coronavirus precautions -

The Church of England have recently issued some guidance on preventing the spread of infection. This relates to the coronavirus, but is also relevant to everyday coughs and colds. If you are unwell, or if you are concerned about being unwell, it is fine to simply receive the bread at Communion. This is called 'receiving in one kind' and is considered to be 'full Communion' - whether or not you take the wine. Please avoid 'dipping' your wafers in the wine as this can actually spread infection. The people administering Communion will be asked to use hand sanitizer prior to Communion. If you are unwell you may also choose to refrain from shaking hands in the Peace - a big smile is sufficient to accompany the words 'Peace be with you'!
